FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES, FULTON COUNTY OFFERS THE AUTOMARK MACHINE, WHICH IS A VOTER-ASSIST TERMINAL BALLOT MARKING DEVICE AT EVERY POLLING PLACE THAT ALLOWS VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES AND OTHER SPECIAL NEEDS TO MARK A BALLOT INDEPENDENTLY AND AS PRIVATELY AS POSSIBLE WHEN USING AN OPTICAL SCAN VOTING SYSTEM. THE TECHNOLOGY ALSO PROVIDES ASSISTANCE TO VOTERS WHO NEED HELP TO BETTER UNDERSTAND WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS.
