
Motion by Commissioner Shives approving the Emergency Rental Assistance Program Subrecipient Agreement between Fulton County and Center for Community Action. All in favor.


The Commissioners met with Patti Hess, Elections Director and Lisa Beatty, Fiscal Administrator regarding Election Matters.


The Commissioners met with Justin Evans, Planning Director/Recycling Coordinator regarding follow up on the Solid Waste Meeting.
