Representatives from the justice system and behavioral health met with the County Commissioners to discuss ongoing collaboration between the courts and mental health services. Recent initiatives—including the implementation of a mental health court co-responder and a recovery supports navigator, along with strengthened existing systems—have increased deferrals to community-based treatment resources. These efforts are supported through blended funding from County Mental Health resources and grants from the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency. Over recent months, the group has observed a notable reduction in the number of individuals incarcerated at the Bedford County Correctional Facility, resulting in measurable cost savings for the county. Next steps include mapping available resources to support training efforts and exploring supported housing options.

Commissioners met with Services for Children Director Christine McQuade to discuss a potential hire for the position of Caseworker II. McQuade also stated that she would be obtaining quotes for a printer and projector.




