Tuesday, April 14, 2026

Commissioner Bunch called the meeting to order followed by prayer. All recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Motion by Commissioner Wible to approve the April 7, 2026 Commissioners' Minutes. All in favor.

Motion by Commissioner Wible to approve the April 7, 2026 Salary Board Minutes. All in favor.

Motion by Commissioner Hann to approve Account Payables, dated April 14, 2026, in the amount of \$126,018.94. All in favor.

Motion by Commissioner Hann to approve Payroll, dated April 17, 2026, in the amount of \$136,650.40. All in favor.

Commissioners met with Chief Tax Assessor Melissa Gordon to discuss Tax Assessment matters.

Fulton County Library Director Jamie Brambley and Library Board President Kirsten Sharpe met with Commissioners to request having a Proclamation signed.

Motion by Commissioner Wible to approve, execute and proclaim April 19-25, 2026 as “2026 National Library Week” to “encourage all residents to visit their library, explore it’s resources, and celebrate all the ways that the library helps our community find joy”. All in favor.

Local Government Specialist Jake DeCarli met with Commissioners for a meet and greet. DeCarli introduced himself and provided the Commissioners with a handout of financial assistant programs and trainings resources available from DCED (Department of Community & Economic Development).

EMA/9-1-1 Director Brian Barton met with Commissioners to request having a Proclamation signed.

Motion by Commissioner Hann to approve, execute and proclaim April 19-25, 2026 as 9-1-1 Public Safety Telecommunicator Week to “recognize men and women of Fulton County 9-1-1 Communications Center whose diligence and professionalism keep our county citizens safe”. All in favor.

Commissioners met with Fiscal Assistant Jessica Sunderland and Executive Program Director Elen Ott with Fulton County Family Partnership to have two resolutions approved and executed.

Motion by Commissioner Bunch to approve and execute Resolution 1 of 2026, “For Execution of dotGrant/Keystone E-Grant Agreements” naming Elen Ott, Executive Program Director of Fulton County Family Partnership, to be directed to execute Public Transportation Operating Application grant agreements with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation on it’s behalf; and to approve and execute Resolution 2 of 2026, “Authorizing the Submittal and Modification of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation dotGrant/Keystone E-Grants Electronic Objects” listing authorized individuals with Fulton County Family Partnership to submit and modify the dotGrant/Keystone E-Grants electronic objects indicated within the chart on the resolution, specifically related to the Public Transportation Operating Application for Welfare to Work funding. All in favor.

Commissioners met with Chief Probation Officer Dan Miller to review and approve contracts.

Motion by Commissioner Bunch to approve and execute “Exhibit B- Initial Year Statement of Work (SOW)”, effective April 14, 2026 through December 31, 2026, to be provided by GovAI Software Solutions to Fulton County; and to approve and execute a “Master Service Agreement” (MSA) entered into between GovAI Software Solutions LLC and Fulton County, providing “software services, technical support, training, and optional add-on modules” commencing on the effective date, April 14, 2026, and remaining in effect for one year. All in favor.

Motion by Commissioner Wible to approve and execute a Letter of Support for the Fulton County Medical Center, addressed to DCED’s ARC State Program Manager Ms. Jennifer Lench. All in favor.

Motion by Commissioner Bunch to authorize Commissioner Wible to execute a "Renewal Application for Existing Certificate of Compliance" for Fulton County Children and Youth Services, with an expiration date of August 1, 2026, submitted by Services for Children Director Christine McQuade. All in favor.

Motion by Commissioner Bunch to approve and execute an inmate physician request form for an inmate located at the BCCF, Bedford County Correction Facility, submitted by Sheriff Sprague. All in favor.

Commissioners met with HR Administrator Mary Huston for HR Matters.

Motion by Commissioner Hann to accept a Resignation Letter from Kassia College, Office Deputy 1 in the Prothonotary's Office, effective immediately. All in favor.

Commissioners recessed at a 11:00 a.m. and resumed their meeting again at 1:00 p.m. for Union Negotiations.

Commissioners met with Ronald Kriel with Teamsters Local Union No. 776 for Union Negotiations. Mediator Tom Wrobleksi was also in attendance along with Union Stewards Jodi Keefer and Jennifer Burdge.

Motion by Commissioner Bunch to enter into Executive Session at 1:00 p.m. for Union Negotiations. All in favor.

Commissioner Bunch departed the meeting at 2:30 p.m.

Motion by Commissioner Wible to exit Executive Session at 3:00 p.m. and adjourn the regular meeting. All in favor.




