Commissioner Bunch called the meeting to order followed by prayer. All recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

**Motion** by Commissioner Wible to approve the April 14, 2026 Commissioners' Minutes. All in favor.

**Motion** by Commissioner Hann to approve Account Payables, dated April 21, 2026, in the amount of \$284,563.75. All in favor.

Interim County Treasurer Amy Bishop met with Commissioners for Treasurer Office updates to include upset and judicial sales and how they are conducted.

Commissioners met with Building and Maintenance Supervisor Brad Seville to discuss getting a county flag made due to the county not having one. Discussion was made about the Boy Scouts performing a ceremony at the County Courthouse on May 1<sup>st</sup> and their desire to take a county flag to DC in celebration of America250PA along with other Pennsylvania county flags. Commissioners agreed for Seville to move forward with having one designed and ordered.

A brief Retirement Board Meeting was held at 8:45 a.m. for a quarterly review with Financial Advisors Denny Koons and Jacob Barr from Raymond James. Separate minutes are on file.

Commissioners met with Calvin Wolfe, Keystone Chapter ABATE Coordinator and Bob Keefer, Assistant Coordinator to have a Motorcycle Safety Proclamation signed.

**Motion** by Commissioner Bunch to approve and execute the Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month Proclamation for May 2026, to “encourage all motorcyclists to continue their efforts to promote safety and motorcycle awareness and all drivers to share the road and respect the unique safety needs of motorcycles”. All in favor.

Public Defender Phil Harper and Assistant Cheryl Deshong met with Commissioners to review information for applying for the PCCD Grant for FY26-27.

**Motion** by Commissioner Bunch to approve and execute the PCCD Grant Application (Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency) for FY26-27 as presented and laid out by the Public Defender’s Office. All in favor.

HR Administrator Mary Huston met with Commissioners to discuss a surplus check from Benecon.

**Motion** by Commissioner Hann authorizing Commissioner Bunch to sign for the Benecon surplus check to be put in a reserve account set up by Benecon earning interest at a rate of 3.35% with S&T Bank. All in favor.

**Motion** on Commissioner Bunch to approve and execute an invoice from Wessel and Co. for CFO services for March 2026, in the amount of \$4,882.50. All in favor.

**Motion** by Commissioner Hann to approve and execute an invoice from Elect IT Solutions for IT Staffing and Support Services for May 2026, in the amount of \$12,598.00. All in favor.

**Motion** by Commissioner Wible to approve and execute an application for burial expenses for Veteran Ryan E. Unger, who served in the Navy in Vietnam during the Vietnam War from June 1968 to June 1972. Payment will be made to surviving spouse Tana Unger. All in favor.

**Motion** by Commissioner Bunch authorizing Commissioner Wible to execute the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter MATP (Medical Assistance Transportation Program) Report for FY25-26. All in favor.

Commissioner Wible executed and Chief Clerk Shives attested an Area on Aging Joint Resolution appointing Connie Brode to the position of Executive Director of the Huntington-Bedford and Fulton Area Agency on Aging that was approved and signed at a previous board meeting.

Juvenile Probation Officer Mary Hann met with Commissioners to have a final document signed for the FY25-26 Juvenile Grant in Aid Award.

**Motion** by Commissioner Hann authorizing Commissioner Bunch to execute a final document for the FY25-26 Juvenile Grant in Aid Award. All in favor.

Jenn Hawbecker, Stacey Brookens with Franklin/Fulton MH/IDD/EI and Fulton County Human Services Director/Executive Development Director Julie Dovey met with Commissioners to provide updates on the Early Intervention Program.

Fulton County Human Services Director/Executive Development Director Julie Dovey met with Commissioners to provide Human Services updates.

**Motion** by Commissioner Hann to adjourn the meeting at 11:15 a.m. All in favor.


