Commissioner Bunch called the meeting to order followed by prayer. All recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Commissioner Bunch opened up the floor for Public Comment Period. County resident Sandra Barton shared a news article from padems.org in regards to the 2020 Election.

Motion by Commissioner Wible to approve the July 14, 2026 Commissioners' Minutes. All in favor.

A brief Retirement Board Meeting was held at 8:45 a.m. with Denny Koons, Raymond James Financial, for a Quarterly Review. Koons presented a portfolio of the pension plan for county employees. Also in attendance were HR Administrator Mary Huston, Fiscal Administrator Sue Reed and Interim County Treasurer Amy Bishop. Separate minutes are on file.

Franklin/Fulton Court Administrator Rebekah Reigner, Deputy Court Administrator Aimee Hutchinson and Elect IT Director Rick Grissinger met with Commissioners to discuss a potential upgrade to the sound system in the Fulton County Courtroom as well as funding opportunities. Reigner presented two updated quotes.

Motion by Commissioner Wible to table the TOPP Business Solution/FTR Gold Quote and illuminated Integration Quote until further discussion on funding for the project. All in favor.

Motion by Commissioner Wible to approve and execute letters to Dawn Strait and Christine Tremi appointing them to the Fulton County Library Board for a 3-year term to expire June 30, 2029. All in favor.

Motion by Commissioner Bunch to approve and execute an Electronic Recording Procedures Agreement presented by Prothonotary Stephanie Sherman dated July 8, 2026 between Fulton County, PA and Simplifile LC, effective January 1, 2027. All in favor.

Motion by Commissioner Wible to approve and execute an estimate from ACS, Access Control Systems, Inc., for a Mobile X-ray Imaging System for the Fulton County Courthouse in the amount of \$2,038.25. All in favor.

Motion by Commissioner Hann to enter into Executive Session for Personnel Matters at 9:41 a.m. All in favor.

Motion by Commissioner Wible to exit Executive Session at 9:55 a.m. All in favor.

Commissioners met via Zoom with SEDA Cog's Program Manager Jamie Shrawder and Project Coordinator Michelle Koslap for the CDBG FFY 2026 Project Selection.

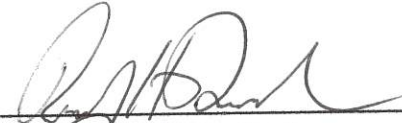

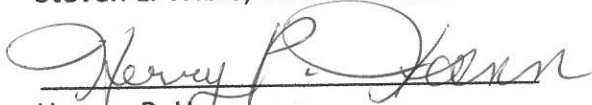
Motion by Commissioner Hann to adjourn at 11:53 a.m. All in favor.

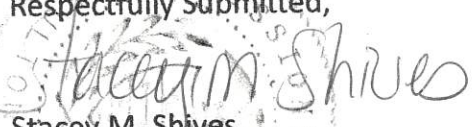
