Extensive efforts have been made to make all polling places in Fulton County accessible to handicapped, disabled, and elderly voters with the full range of disabilities. For individuals with disabilities, Fulton County offers the auto mark machine, which is a voter-assist terminal ballot marking device at every polling place that allows all voters and ones with disabilities and other special needs to mark a ballot independently and as privately as possible when using an optical scan voting system. The technology also provides assistance to voters who need help to better understand written instructions.
